Los Angeles Superior Courts to close 1 day a month.

As some of you may have already heard, Los Angeles Superior Court announced Tuesday that they will be implementing a one day per month (Furlough day) closure. Starting on Wednesday, July 15, 2009, and recurring on every third Wednesday of each month through June, 2010, all normal court operations will be closed due to the continuing budget crisis. On each of these days there will be skeleton crews at some locations to handle emergency matters. It is yet to be determined what constitutes an "emergency matter".

How this will affect statute deadlines, hearing dates and filing deadlines are some of many topics being discussed by court officials. The court hopes to release more information as soon as it is determined in the next several days.

The County Recorders office will not be affected by the closures.

We will keep you apprised as to any new information on this topic.
