

- **Will LASC require Courtesy Copies?**

- ✓ Anything with a hearing within 2 days will require a courtesy copy
- ✓ Any printed document required pursuant to a Standing or General Order
- ✓ Pleadings and motions (including attachments such as declarations and exhibits) of 26 pages or more
- ✓ Pleadings and motions that include points and authorities
- ✓ Demurrers
- ✓ Anti-SLAPP filings, pursuant to CCP 425.16
- ✓ Motions for Summary Judgment/Adjudication
- ✓ Motions to Compel Further Discovery
- ✓ Also see courtroom specific rules on [www.lacourt.org](http://www.lacourt.org) under "Courtroom Information"

- **What are the File size requirements?**

- ✓ We have tested up to 180MB and the filing successfully went through.
- ✓ Court has mentioned to check the FAQs, so far it is not listed yet
- ✓ There is a chance that they do not have a limit

- **Will Bookmarking and OCR be required?**

- ✓ Yes. The court will require all exhibits are bookmarked. They encourage hyperlinks to the page you reference also.
- ✓ The court will not require pagination

- **Are there any documents exempt from eFiling?**

The following documents are exempt from eFiling:

- ✓ Peremptory Challenges
- ✓ Bonds/undertaking documents
- ✓ Trial and hearing exhibits

- **What are the fees to eFile?**

- ✓ Janney & Janney charges \$9.00 per transaction or \$25.00 for an Assisted eFiling (we eFile for you on your behalf)
- ✓ U.D. and Collection cases = \$2.45
- ✓ All other case types = \$2.95
- ✓ + an additional \$1.75 Court Technology Fee
- ✓ \$13.20 total for UD/Collection cases
- ✓ \$13.70 for all other case types

- **How long will my document take to be accepted by the court?**

- ✓ Per court slide revealed on Tuesday eFilings will take 2 hours, to 2 days, or more.
- ✓ Will depend on document types

- **If my documents are rejected, will I get a rejection notice, or just a status update note?**

- ✓ Yes, a Notice of Confirmation will be supplied with the rejection reason next to the document name. If accepted and a statutory fee was added, the fee will list next to the document type.
